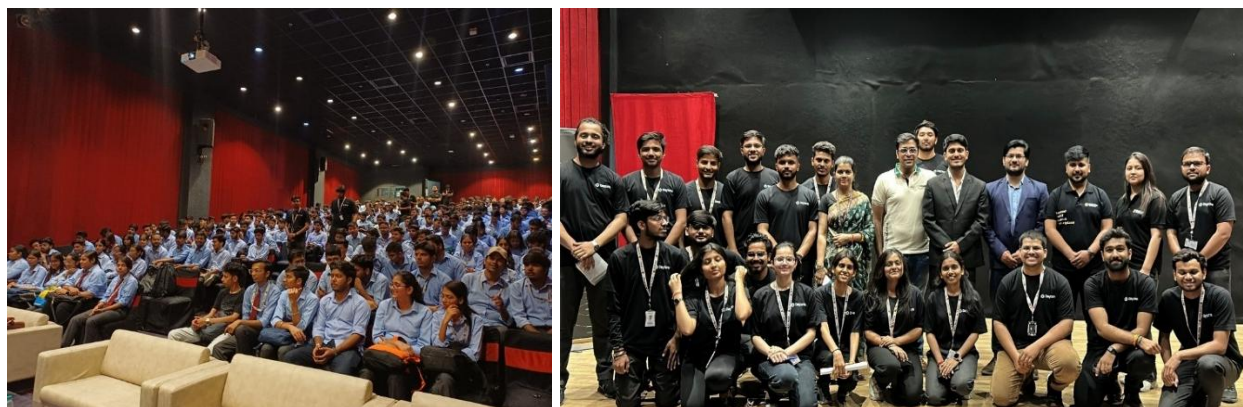
Name of the Event: Daytona Meetup - Delhi Edition

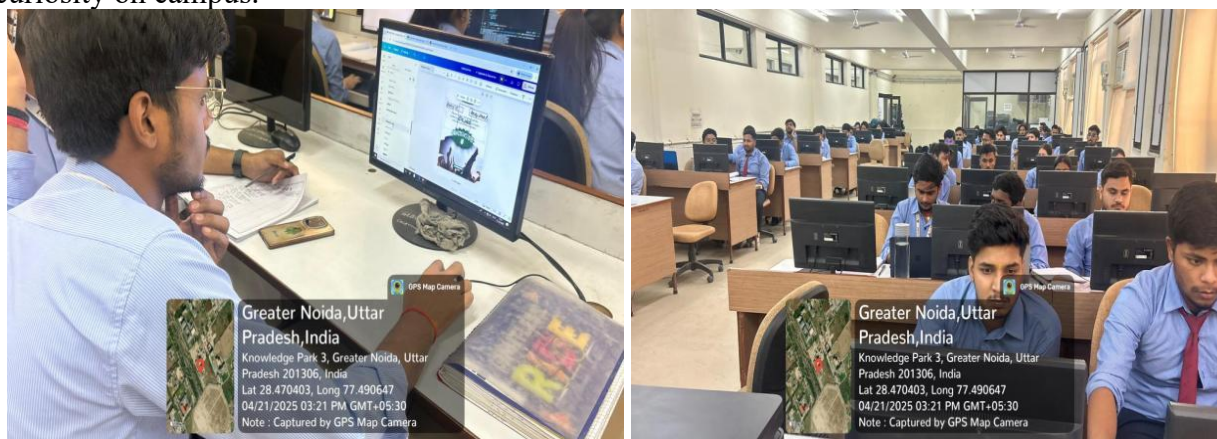
Name of the Event: World Creativity & Innovation Day

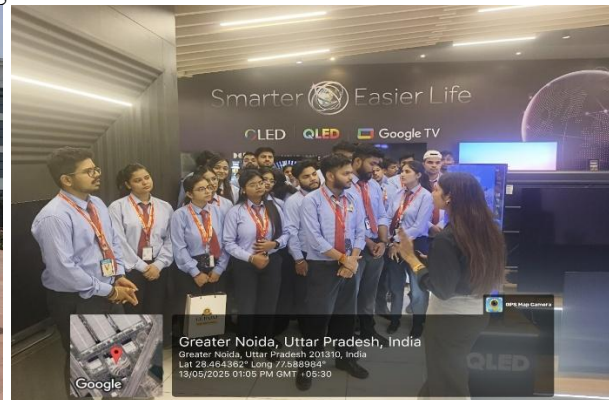
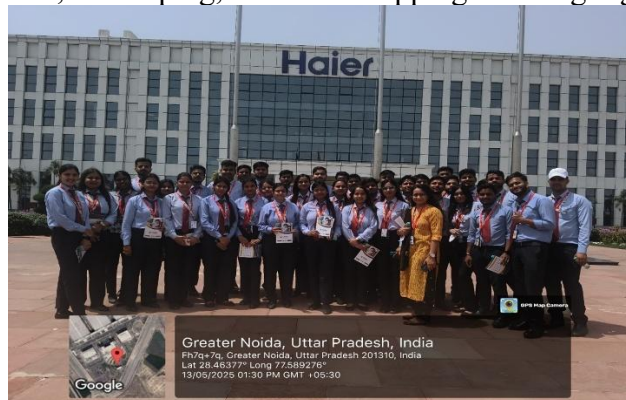
Name of the Event: Industrial Visit to Haier Appliances India Pvt. Ltd.

Date: 13.5.2025

Department: MBA

As part of the Department of Management Studies' initiative to enhance practical learning through industrial exposure, MBA students undertook a visit to Haier Appliances Ltd. The experience offered deep insights into advanced manufacturing practices and quality management in the home appliance industry.

The students were introduced to the 6S strategy – Sort, Set in order, Shine, Standardize, Sustain, and Safety – a foundational aspect of Haier's operational excellence. A detailed walkthrough of the semi-automatic washing machine manufacturing process (7–11 kg range) was provided, covering stages from base and pulsator assembly to auto strapping and packaging. Quality assurance procedures were also demonstrated, including voltage checks, noise elimination, performance evaluation, and drainage inspection. For product protection, components like bottom EPS, auto taping, and auto strapping were highlighted.



Name of the Event: Waste To Wealth -Eco-Innovation Challenge 2025

The central theme was to identify local waste problems and propose innovative, scalable business solutions that convert waste into valuable products or services. Participants presented eco-startup ideas focusing on upcycling, biodegradable products, circular economy models, and tech-enabled waste segregation systems.

Expert mentors from academia evaluated the solutions based on innovation, feasibility, impact, and entrepreneurial potential. The top three teams were awarded certificates and goodies and mentoring support from Innovation ambassadors.

The event not only aligned with the IIC's mission of fostering innovation and entrepreneurship but also contributed to the national sustainability goals and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). It provided a platform for students to collaborate, ideate, and transform environmental challenges into business opportunities, embodying the spirit of innovation for a cleaner and greener future.



Name of the Event: Industrial Visit to Yakult Danon Pvt. Ltd.

Date: 14-15.05.2025

The visit to Yakult was insightful and informative. Students were introduced to the detailed manufacturing process of Yakult's signature probiotic drinks, covering everything from raw material sourcing, fermentation, bottling, quality assurance, to packaging.

Students learned about Yakult's implementation of the 5S methodology – Sort, Set in order, Shine, Standardize, sustain – along with rigorous safety protocols to ensure a clean and secure production environment. The guide elaborated on Yakult's multi-step production process, which includes the culturing of *Lactobacillus casei* Shirota, quality-controlled fermentation, sterile bottling, and packaging. Various checkpoints were demonstrated, including pH level testing, temperature monitoring, and hygiene checks by international food safety standards. The team at Yakult conducted Q&A sessions, during which students could interact with industry professionals and gain insights into supply chain logistics, marketing strategies, and international compliance.



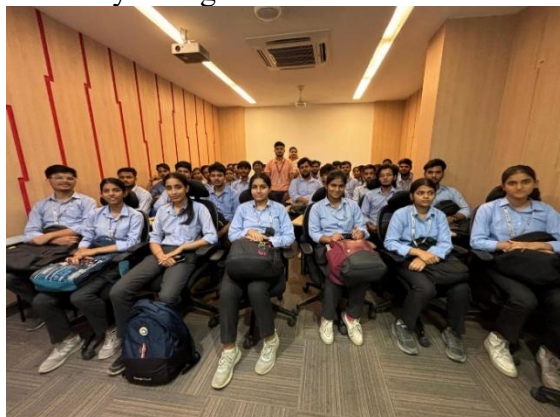
Name of the Event: Exposure Visit to Incubation Unit/Patent Facilitation Centre/Technology Transfer Centre

The incubation unit, GL Bajaj Center for Research and Incubation, is a well-established center that supports budding entrepreneurs through mentorship, infrastructure, funding support, and business development resources. It hosts startups from various sectors including technology, education, and social impact.

The visit began with a welcome address by Ms. Deeksha Rai, Manager, GLBCRI, who provided a brief history and mission of the incubation unit. A detailed presentation highlighted key statistics, success stories, partner institutions, and the incubation process. Visitors were given a guided tour of the incubation center including co-working spaces, labs, meeting rooms, and innovation labs. The team interacted with startup founders, learning about their products, challenges, and how the incubation unit supports them. A question-and-answer session helped clarify specific queries related to funding, intellectual property support, and industry linkages.



Name of the Event: Protecting Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) and IP Management for start-ups

In addition, Dr. Bhatt shed light on the legal frameworks and procedural requirements governing IPRs at both national and international levels. He highlighted common challenges faced by start-ups in protecting and managing their intellectual property assets, such as limited resources, lack of awareness, and navigating complex regulatory processes. The session also included case studies and practical guidance on how start-ups can integrate IP considerations into their business strategies from the outset.
